DWARF EUROPEAN

Height: 2-3' Spread: 2-4

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade, wet or

heavy soil

Shape: Dense, mounded

Foliage: Small, glossy green, tri-lobed

Notes: Grown for its dense mounding habit and small size. White flowers are sporadic.



Height: 6-8' Spread: 6-8'

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade

Shape: Compact, rounded

Foliage: Thick, dark green, purple-red in fall

Notes: Creamy white, flat-topped flowers cover the plant in late April or early May, followed by orange-red fruit in early July lasting a month before turning black in fall.

NANNYBERRY

Height: 15-20' **Spread:** 6-10'

Location: Zone 2, sun to shade, wet to dry sites

Shape: Vase-like, upright, arching

Foliage: Glossy green, purplish-red in fall

Notes: This large native shrub has white flowers in the spring and blue-black fruit in the

fall which is attractive to birds.
