

SPREADING JUNIPER –BLUE

GREY OWL

Juniperus virginiana 'Grey Owl'

Height: 2' **Spread:** 4'

Location: Zone 2, full sun

Notes: Good for hot, poor, dry soil and city conditions. Foliage is a smoky blue-gray and holds its color well in winter. Produces an abundance of silvery berries, often used for winter decorations.



HUGHES

Juniperus horizontalis 'Hughes'

Height: 12-18" **Spread:** 6-8'

Location: Zone 3, full sun

Notes: Graceful branches are beautiful cascading over rocks or walls or as a groundcover. Retains its silver-blue foliage color through winter.



MANEY

Juniperus cinensis 'Maneyi'

Height: 4-5' **Spread:** 5-6'

Location: Zone 3, full sun, salt tolerant

Notes: An upright, spreading, bushy juniper with a blue cast to its foliage. Grey green berries and one of the hardiest evergreens.



WILTON BLUE RUG

Juniperus horizontalis 'Wiltoni'

Height: 4-6" **Spread:** 3-5'

Location: Zone 3, sun to light shade

Notes: A trailing juniper having a uniform, full centered growth habit with intense silver-blue foliage. Tips turn purple in winter.
