

# QUAKING ASPEN

*Populus tremuloides*

**Height:** 50-75'                      **Spread:** 30'

**Location:** Zone 2, sun, tolerates wet or dry sites

**Shape:** Pyramidal to round crown

**Foliage:** Small, light green, yellow in fall.

**Notes:** An oval, medium sized tree known for its leaves which tremble in the breeze, excellent yellow fall color and white to gray-green bark. Pyramidal in youth becoming oval, loose, open, informal, sometimes irregular. Native across most of Canada and throughout the US from Alaska to Georgia; the most widely distributed plant in North America.
