

# COTONEASTER

*Cotoneaster*

## CRANBERRY

**Height:** 2-3'      **Spread:** 3-6'

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to part shade.

**Shape:** Dense, spreading, arching branches

**Foliage:** Small, glossy dark green, bronze in fall

**Notes:** Superb low hedge formed by spreading branches that display an interesting herringbone pattern. Drought and salt tolerant, good for bank cover. Small pinkish flowers in early summer; 1/4" cranberry red fruit are abundantly produced in the fall and remain on branch through winter.



## PEKING/HEDGE

**Height:** 8-10'      **Spread:** 4-6'

**Location:** Zone 3, sun to part shade, drought tolerant

**Shape:** Dense, upright

**Foliage:** Dark green, red in fall

**Notes:** Upright form, a natural hedge or screen; reddish flowers followed by interesting, long-lasting black fruit. Orange-red fall foliage. Thrives in poor soil, needs little maintenance.
